- Supporting the development of ESA's strategic plans by identifying strategic challenges and opportunities as well as strategic options, and to develop relevant goals and objectives, in accordance with mid- and long-term priorities at Agency and directorate levels.
- Building up and maintaining Strategic Foresight networks.
